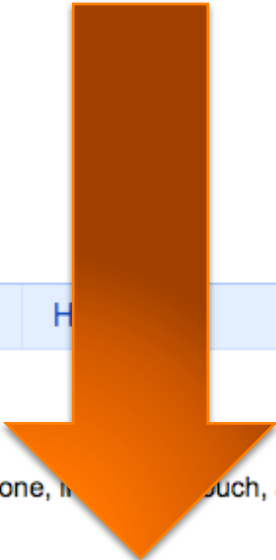

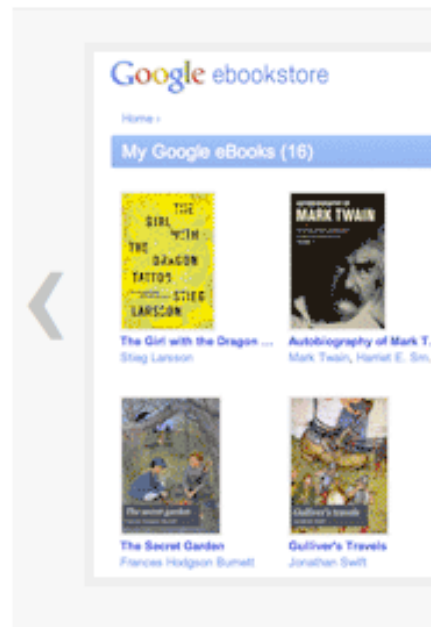

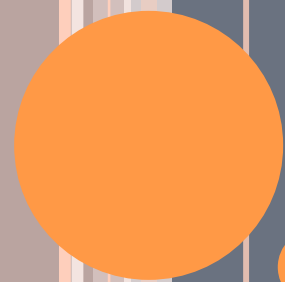

1. Set up an account at Watermark Books
2. Create a Google account
3. Install software on your eReader
 - Nook
 - Sony
 - Android phone
 - iPhone, iPad, iPod Touch

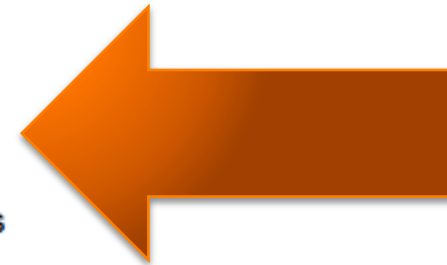

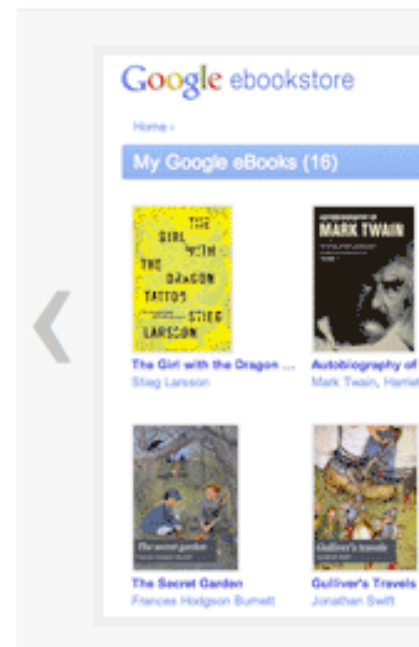

IPAD AS EREADER

IPAD HARDWARE

- Weighs 1.5 pounds
Compare to 10.2 ounces for Kindle
- Attracts fingerprints
Can be wiped away with fabric
- Back-lit display may cause eye strain
But not everyone reports this

Download all via App Store or iTunes

Books

- Apple iBook
- Kindle for iPad
- Stanza for iPad

- Magazine-specific apps

Newspaper

APPLE IBOOKS

- Read books purchased from the iBookstore, as well as non-DRMd epub-formatted books and PDFs
- Visually pleasing, and little touches like the page turning animation heightened my enjoyment of reading on the app
- Ability to add notes to epub files; not PDFs
- Books and notes sync to iBooks on the iPhone
- iBooks Bookshelf lets you change the order of how books appear on your bookshelf
- You can only view iBookstore from within the iBooks app.



KINDLE APP

- Download the Kindle app from the App Store
- Sign on to your Kindle account
- You'll be able to synch all your Kindle books using the Archived Books
- Kindle app is available on iOS, Mac, PC, Adroid, Blackberry



BARNES AND NOBLE NOOK

- Customizable themes
- You can add notes and bookmarks
- You can also Google or look up highlighted text on Wikipedia



STANZA

- Side-loadable—lets you open with both ebooks and PDFs
- You can annotate non-PDF books
- You can also use iTunes file-sharing to transfer content



ZINIO

- More an e-magazine reader than an e-book reader


